	1) The student must be a child (includes adopted child or stepchild) of a Purple Heart recipient, alive or deceased, who was relieved or discharged from service in the Armed Forces of the United States with either an honorable discharge or a general discharge under honorable conditions and was awarded the Purple Heart in 2001 or thereafter for wounds received in combat.

	2) The child (includes adopted child or stepchild), spouse, or unremarried surviving spouse of a member of the United States Armed Forces who:			
	a) Died while on active duty, <b>or</b>			
	b) Died as a result of a military service-connected disability, <b>or</b>			
	c) Is 100% disabled as the result of a military service-connected disability as certified by the Department of Veterans Affairs or any branch of the Armed Forces of the United States.			
	d) An eligible child must be 23 years of age or younger at the time the child applies for the waiver.

Award Amount	The maximum waiver granted under this remission program shall be:
